# GTvre | Pom pom beanie by Mélissa Thibault for Bāskå



### **GAUGE**

9 dc and 5 rows = 10 cm

### SIZE

56 cm (expendable)

# **MATERIALS**

Bernat Roving (81 g / 110 yd)

or #5 bulky

Hook 7 mm

Needle and sewing thread

1 Bāskå pom pom

# **ABBREVIATIONS**

st - stitch

ch – chain

sc — single crochet

hdc — half double crochet

dc - double crochet

### Special techniques:

Work in front loop of half double crochet with wrong side of work facing you.

# Half double crochet have 3 loops, you have to work in the front loop of these 3 loops. Here is a view from above a stitch work in front loop.

Leave a sufficient length of thread for sewing, chain 21.

Row 1 – 1 hdc in each st until the end of row, turn.

Row 2 – Work in front loop only in hdc of the previous row. 1 hdc in each st until the end of row, turn.

Row 3-1 hdc in each st until the end of row, turn.

**Row 4 to 29 –** Repeat row 2 and 3.

Row 30 - Repeat row 2.

(If you want smaller of larger head size you can decrease or increase the number of rows but you need to finish by peer row. Exemple for total of rows: 26, 28, 32, 34.... After, on round 1, you have to distribute a equivalent number of dc.)

Sew both sides of the rectangle together to form a tube.

Rnd 1 – Distrubute stitch allong the top of the tube, working 2 dc together until the end of rnd. Now you have distribute 30 dc (15 groups of dc together) join. For distribute this stitch you have to work in between loop of the stitch like that:

Rnd 2-2 dc together until the last group of dc, 1 dc, join. For work this round you have to work in back post of the group of dc together of the previous row, just like that:





Rnd 3 – work in back post of the dc together group in the previous row, 2 sc together until the end of rnd, join.

Fasten off.

So now you could attach a Bāskå pom pom with needle and sewing thread. You may use pliers to pull the needle through the pom pom when the leather is very thick.
